Minutes of the Regular Meeting Of the Board of Directors Wednesday, July 26, 2023

The Meeting of the Board of Directors of the Merquin County Water District called to order in regular session at 19684 Second Ave., Stevinson, California 6:00 p.m.

Present were, President Adam Azevedo, Vice President Freddy Oliviera, Director Danny Drumonde, Absent: Director Rick Jones, Director Phil Dores

Meeting Called to Order: 6:02 p.m.

Information Workshop regarding Potential Increased Water Standby Assessment.

Sean Pinkston of Quad/Knof Presented the Informational Workshop.

The Merquin County Water District currently has an annual assessment of \$9.00 per acre, this assessment is used for the operation and maintenance of the District Wells to provide additional flow during normal water years and provide 100% of the water during critical dry years. Pumping also reduces the water table allowing the growing of a wider range of crops.

Why are rate changes being considered:

- The increase in the annual assessment is being considered for additional funds to maintain the operation of the groundwater wells within the District.
- Increased costs of operation and general cost increase since the last rate study (2013).
- Rates must be increased to avoid a significant budget shortfall. The District has been losing money the last 2 fiscal years.
- The adjustment to the assessment charge per acre will be used for well replacement, Pump & Motor Replacement and Operation & Maintenance as defined in the Assessment Report out for Public review.

Annual Assessment

- The proposed annual Assessment increases the Assessment up to \$20.00 per acre per year (and \$11.00/acre increase).
- The Board can decide each year as to the amount to set the annual Assessment prior to August of each year for the following year tax roll produced by the County of Merced.
- The Current rate is \$9.00 per acre per year.

Rate Comparison:

- · Chowchilla Water District \$24.00, plus \$16/acre supplemental assessment
- Madera Irrigation District \$18.40, plus \$32.53/acre for Bond Payoff Acceleration
- Merced Irrigation District \$24.00
- Merguin County Water District \$9.00

- Prop 218
- Proposition 218 focuses "on exactions, whether they are called taxes, fees, or charges, which are directly associated with property ownership."
- Proposition 218 provides no new authority to impose taxes, assessments, or fees. (Cal. Const. art. XIII D, § 1.) Under Proposition 218, the only taxes, assessments, fees, or charges that local government may impose on a parcel or a person "as an incident of property ownership" are ad valorem property taxes, special taxes, and assessments approved in the provisions of its article XIII D, section 4, and fees or charges for a property-related service consistent with its article XIII D, section 6. (Cal. Const. art. XIII D, § 3.)
- Proposition 218 added articles XIII C ("Voter Approval for Local Levies")10 and XIII D ("Assessment and Property Related Fee Reform")11 to the California Constitution

Civil Engineer Eric Swenson:

1. Discussion/Action: District office painting and exterior repair. The current exterior building condition has deteriorated to the point where some sheeting is fairly porous, and some openings are large enough to allow rodent intrusion. Continued weathering without protective coating will result in potential moisture and rodent intrusion.

The District Engineer recommends:

- a. Cleaning of the exterior building surface.
- b. Repair/replacement of damaged siding.
- c. Patching, caulking, and sanding of exterior surfaces.
- d. Apply one coat of primer and two topcoats of paint.
- e. Apply non-slip weather resistant coating to access ramp at front of building.

Section 1720 of the California Labor Code appears to apply to this work which requires paying of prevailing wages. One contractor quotation (Crown Painting) to complete this work has been obtained to date for \$24,000. The work should be completed prior to the Fall rains.

The District Engineer recommends:

- a. Cleaning of the exterior building surface.
- b. Repair/replacement of damaged siding.
- c. Patching, caulking, and sanding of exterior surfaces.
- d. Apply one coat primer and two topcoats of paint.
- e. Apply non-slip weather resistant coating to access ramp at front of building.

Section 1720 of the California Labor Code appears to apply to this work which requires paying of prevailing wages.

One contractor quotation (Crown Painting) to complete this work has been obtained to date for \$24,000. The work should be completed prior to the Fall rains.

The Board generally concurred that the office building needs repair and painting before the winter of 2023/2024. The Board requested the Engineer get a second quote to stay in line with MCWD rules.

2. Discussion/Action: Certify District Boundary Map. The County GIS (graphical information systems) office has requested that we certify an electronic District boundary map. Staff is proposing the following modifications to the map submitted by the County:

3. <u>Discussion/Action</u>: Develop MCWD 2023/2024 Budget. Merced County has requested. that a budget be submitted by the end of August 2023. During this period 2 new wells with pumps and electrical services are planned to be installed, some pipelining work is

proposed, and the District Engineer will be replaced. Also, the potential to form a JPA with SWD is under discussion. These changes all need to be reflected in this budget. The budget assumes that the Standby Assessment Rate is increased to \$12/Acre and that the price of District water during the normal irrigation season increases to \$50/AF through a 218 process currently underway.


4. <u>Discussion/Action</u>: DRAFT 2024-2027 MCWD Budget. In order to proceed with the 218 process for an increased water rate, budgets for the next 4 years need to be developed. The 2023/2024 budget has already been presented. The following budget encompasses the following 3 years. Staff-related costs are assumed to increase by 5% per year with the exception of a new technician being added in 2025. The new technician is to support maintenance when burning of Ag waste will no longer be permitted by the Air Board. This budget is presented with a \$2/year/acre increase in the Standby Assessment. Price for inseason irrigation water is assumed to be \$50/AF. Unknows for this future projection include the inflation rate and in particular the increased rate of electrical utility costs.


