Civil Engineer Eric Swenson:

- 1. <u>Discussion/Action</u>: Well 10R status update. MSGSA has issued a letter stating a Consistency Determination with the new proposed well. The drilling permit from Merced County likely will be issued October 11, 2023.
- 2. Discussion/Action: Well 7R Status electrical service update. Opportunity for Board members to share electrical quotations for this project. No additional cost proposals have been obtained. Director Freddy Oliviera stated he will get quotes.

- 5. <u>Discussion</u>: MCWD District Boundary Reorganization, reduction in MCWD Sphere of Influence.
 - 2023/2024 Capital Construction Project: Eastside Canal Crossing. SWD is looking to MCWD to draft a Revocable License Agreement for this crossing for them to review. SWD has stated the following items should be included:
- MCWD shall be responsible for any necessary permitting.
- MCWD will be responsible for supervision of construction to ensure the pipeline is installed following generally accepted construction standards for excavation, pipe bedding and placement, joint construction, and other activities.
- SWD/ESCC will retain access to the site during construction and operation of the pipeline.
- In the event of an emergency where repair of the canal embankment or crossing requires disturbance or removal of portions of the pipeline, SWD/ESCC shall notify MCWD of the need for emergency action but shall require no approval from MCWD for performance of the activity. SWD/ESCC shall assume no liability for damages to the pipeline that result from such emergency activity. Should such activities become necessary, SWD/ESCC shall attempt to minimize damage to the pipeline when performing the action.
- The licensing agreement will have a 7-year term with an option to renew and extend.
- The agreement will include standard indemnification language.
- The agreement will have an attachment with the drawings MCWD has provided that show details of the pipeline alignment and construction.
- MCWD will preserve and protect the work and maintain a safe workplace and will assume full responsibility for the condition of the workplace and completion of the work.
- o MCWD will be liable for any loss or damage SWD/ESCC experiences during the course of construction or as a result of operation of the pipeline. Any such damage will be immediately repaired by MCWD. Upon failure to do so, SWD/ESCC may perform the necessary repairs and charge MCWD for the cost of the repair. SWD/ESCC will have the right to inspect the work to confirm that it corresponds to the agreed design and to approve the work upon its completion. This right does not confer upon SWD/ESCC any responsibility for direction or supervision of construction.

The Board directed the District Engineer to work with the District's legal consultant to draft a non-exclusive license agreement including the above listed items.
